R41-12 is an early dent hybrid that is broadly adapted. Position along Hwy 2 corridor and north to Canadian border in ND & MN and east into Wisconsin. This hybrid has excellent early vigor, grain drydown with a girthy ear and very good stalk and root strength.

-  Good choice for cold soils
-  Position on all soil types
-  Plant med-high to high populations
-  Harvest timing– normal to late
